LETTER FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SCHOOL'S GOVERNING BODY

Dear Parents of Pupils Enrolling in 2026

WELCOME

On behalf of the Governing Body of Stirling High School I extend a warm welcome to our new pupils and to their parents. I have no doubt that your relationship with the school will be a happy one and I urge parents to become involved in the life of the school. Your support at meetings and sporting and cultural events will also be appreciated. An important purpose of this letter is to explain the school fee structure to you.

DETERMINATION OF SCHOOL FEES FOR 2026 AND SCHOOL FEE ASSISTANCE

At a meeting of parents held on Wednesday, 5 November 2025, and called in terms of Section 38(2) of the South African Schools Act, No. 84 of 1996, parents met to make important decisions for 2026 with regard to the school's budget for 2026 and the school fee for 2026. Financial assistance in the form of partial or complete exemption for the payment of school fees have also been promulgated by the state and are applicable to all schools. I am happy to report that the budget and determination of the school fee were approved unanimously.

FEES

Fee Structure and School Fee Assistance

The school fee for 2026 has been determined on a sliding scale. It is the view of the parent body that parents who pay fees by way of a debit order should pay a slightly reduced fee. This is because the school is better able to plan its finances as income is more regular. Parents who apply for a reduction in school fees are also encouraged to make use of the debit order system as the amount to be paid will be adjusted should a reduction be applied for and granted. It is also important to note that debits are generated on a monthly basis by the school and that alterations can therefore be made during the year.

A debit order application form is attached and I urge all parents to make use of this most convenient form of payment. It is also the safest means of payment as cash does not have to be transported.

I suggest that the completed debit order form be handed in at the school's office, before the end of January 2026. Parents are also welcome to hand the form in at the school's office prior to the end of the current school year or email the form to leroux@stirlinghigh.co.za.

TEXT BOOKS AND STATIONERY

On the advance payment of a levy of eight hundred rand (R800), the school will lend textbooks to pupils for the year, and will give to pupils the stationery supplies that are normally issued at the commencement of the year. The R800 was included in the enrollment deposit for all new pupils to the school in 2026. Stationery supplies are confined to exercise books and other paper items required. It is suggested that this amount be paid in advance so as to ensure that books may be issued timeously. **The receipt for the payment of the R800 must be presented by the pupil (excluding Grade Eight) at the time that the books and stationery are issued.** This is for control purposes at the issuing point.

SCHOOL FEE - 2026

The school fee for 2026 is R42 240.00 for one child at Stirling High School and R84 480.00 for a family of two or more children from the same family attending Stirling High School if the fee is not paid by debit order.

PAYMENT STRUCTURE

Fees are due and payable at the commencement of the year. However, payments may be made on a monthly or quarterly basis in advance. This can best be illustrated in tabular form.

SCHOOL FEE ASSISTANCE

The forms to be completed by parents for school fee assistance will be available at the school office from the commencement of the new school year. Applications should be received by the school by 12 June 2026 at the latest. Parents who presently have children at Stirling High School and who were granted school fee assistance in 2025 are required to apply again in 2026 should they require assistance as an application is only valid for one year. Please note that the school does not get reimbursed by the Department of Education when school fee assistance is granted. Fees paid prior to the assistance being approved will not be refunded.
